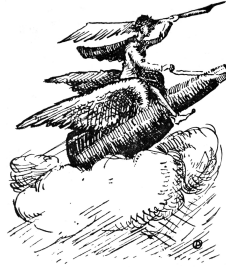

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BYLAWS:

- No. 1. The Society shall be known as the Don Marquis Double Scotch and Prohibition Society.
